

BLAs must remain vigilant on SIR process, says TPCC Chief Mahesh Kumar



Sangareddy (Telangana), June 23 (UNI)

Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC) President and MLC Mahesh Kumar on Tuesday called upon Congress Booth Level Agents (BLAs) to remain vigilant and develop a thor-

ough understanding of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process to safeguard voters' rights. Addressing an awareness meeting for Congress BLAs of the Andole constituency at Sangupet in Sangareddy district, Mahesh Kumar said the role of BLAs was crucial in ensuring

that every eligible voter was included in the electoral rolls and that no errors occurred during the revision process. Mahesh Kumar Goud expressed concern over what he described as attempts to remove secular votes from electoral rolls and stressed that the Election Commission should function as an autonomous constitutional body. Recalling the tenure of former Chief Election Commissioner T. N. Seshan, he said the institution had earned widespread respect under his leadership. Emphasising the importance of every vote, he said a single vote could determine the fate of a government and urged BLAs to work in coordination with party leaders to ensure the inclusion of

all eligible voters. The TPCC chief also claimed that the Congress government had fulfilled nearly 70 per cent of its election promises and asserted that the welfare of the poor and empowerment of women remained its primary objectives. He criticised the BRS, alleging that people had not forgotten its past governance and said the Congress was continuing to register victories in elections across the state. The meeting was attended by Congress Telangana in-charge Meenakshi Natarajan, AICC Secretary Sachin Sawant, Minister Damodara Raja Narasimha, MLA Parigi Rammoan Reddy, TPCC Working President T. Jagga Reddy and other party leaders.

Seethakka calls for coordinated action to transform Telangana villages



Hyderabad, June 23 (UNI)

Telangana Panchayat Raj and Rural Development Minister Danasari Anasuya Seethakka on Tuesday directed officials to work in close coordination to transform villages across the state into model villages, stating that development could be achieved only through a collective and planned approach. Chairing a state-level review meeting of the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Departments at Jyotirao Phule Praja Bhavan, Seethakka reviewed district-wise progress of development works and welfare schemes with Additional Collectors, ZP CEOs, DRDOs and DPOs. The Minister reviewed the implementation of the Employment Guarantee Scheme, generation of work-days, payment of pending material bills, construction of Anganwadi centres, Mahila Shakti buildings and Gram Panchayat offices, water conservation measures, check dams, rural roads and works under the Pradhan Mantri

Krishi Sinchayee Yojana. She also examined sanitation management, house tax collection, utilisation of 15th Finance Commission funds and drinking water supply during the monsoon season. Unveiling 'Jalasisri' posters aimed at improving groundwater levels in villages, Seethakka said all departments must prepare joint action plans and work together to achieve comprehensive rural development. She noted that thousands of crores of rupees would be available to villages over the next five years and stressed the need for effective utilisation of funds. The Minister directed officials to prepare village-level development plans within the next two months and ensure that every scheme directly benefits the public. She warned that strict action would be taken against diversion or misuse of Gram Panchayat funds and emphasized that expenditure should strictly follow prescribed norms, including approval through Gram Sabhas.

KTR slams house arrest of Prashanth Reddy, calls it attack on democratic rights



Hyderabad, June 23 (UNI)

Bharat Rashtira Samiti (BRS) working president K T Rama Rao on Tuesday strongly condemned the house arrest of former minister and Balkonda MLA Vemula Prashanth Reddy, terming it an example of the Congress government's "anti-democratic and autocratic" attitude. Prashanth Reddy was reportedly placed under house arrest while preparing to participate in a protest at the Tadwai Mandal headquarters in Yellaredy constituency. The protest aimed to highlight issues related to fertiliser supply and to oppose the app-based system being implemented for urea distribution. Speaking to Prashanth Reddy over the phone, KTR alleged that the government's attempt to suppress leaders raising questions on behalf of farmers was highly reprehensible. He said that while farmers across Telangana were struggling to obtain urea, the government was failing to address the problem and instead using the

police to silence those who questioned it. The BRS leader accused the government of trying to cover up its failure to ensure adequate fertiliser supply by restricting opposition leaders. He claimed that forcing farmers to stand in queues and face hardships due to the app-based distribution system had exposed the government's failure in safeguarding farmers' interests. KTR said it was unfortunate that the government had responded to concerns over the shortage of urea—an essential agricultural input—with police action rather than addressing farmers' grievances. Stating that fighting for farmers' issues was not a crime, KTR asserted that questioning the government on behalf of the people was the constitutional right of the opposition. He warned that neither BRS leaders nor farmers could be intimidated by house arrests, restrictions or threats, and said the party would continue to raise issues affecting the farming community.

KTR alleges Metro asset scam, targets Congress and BJP over Hyderabad projects

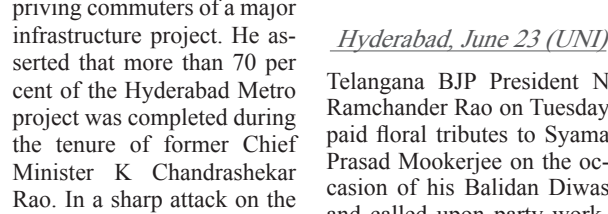

Bharat Rashtira Samiti (BRS) Working President K T Rama Rao on Tuesday alleged that Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy and union Minister G Kishan Reddy were staging "political dramas" over the Hyderabad Metro Rail issue while concealing what he described as a major scam involving Metro Rail-linked assets worth nearly Rs 30,000 crore. Addressing a BRS cadre meeting in Serilingampally, KTR alleged that the Chief Minister was attempting to take control of around 250 acres of Metro-linked land and assets by burdening the

also claimed that the Airport Metro Express project initiated during the previous BRS regime was shelved after the Congress came to power, depriving commuters of a major infrastructure project. He asserted that more than 70 per cent of the Hyderabad Metro project was completed during the tenure of former Chief Minister K Chandrababoo Naidu. In a sharp attack on the state government, KTR accused Revanth Reddy of dismantling welfare and development initiatives launched by the previous government and alleged irregularities in the proposed Musi River project. He also criticised Serilingampally MLA Arikupudi Gandhi and urged party workers to strengthen the BRS and actively participate in the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) programme. KTR expressed confidence that the BRS would return to power and claimed that only then would Hyderabad Metro Rail regain momentum and development-oriented governance be restored in Telangana.

BJP workers must draw inspiration from Syama Prasad Mookerjee's sacrifice: Ramchander Rao

Telangana BJP President N Ramchander Rao on Tuesday paid floral tributes to Syama Prasad Mookerjee on the occasion of his Balidan Diwas and called upon party workers to draw inspiration from his life of sacrifice, courage and commitment to national unity. Addressing the media, Ramchander Rao said Dr Mookerjee's life stood as a shining example of dedication to the nation and unwavering commitment to national interests. He noted that the Telangana BJP State Office was named after Dr Syama Prasad Mookerjee on the suggestion of veteran BJP leader L. K. Advani, who drew parallels between the historical situations of Hyderabad and Jammu and Kashmir in the 1950s. He said that while Hyderabad was under the Nizam's rule, Jammu and

Kashmir faced challenges of complete integration with India. Just as Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel played a decisive role in integrating Hyderabad and other princely states, Dr Mookerjee sacrificed his life for the complete integration of Jammu and Kashmir with the Indian Union, he added. Ramchander Rao said Dr Mookerjee played a historic role in ensuring that West Bengal remained an integral part of India and fought fearlessly for the protection of Hindus while opposing divisive and appeasement politics. He described him as a distinguished scholar and administrator who became the youngest Vice-Chancellor of University of Calcutta and always placed national interests above personal power or position. He further stated that Dr. Mookerjee resigned from the cabinet.

Mallu Ravi leads protest against SIR process, demands protection of voting rights



Hyderabad, June 23 (UNI)

TPCC Disciplinary Committee Chairman and Nagarkurnool MP Mallu Ravi on Tuesday participated in a massive protest rally in Hyderabad organized by the Congress, CPI, TJS and Left parties against the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) process, alleging that it threatened the constitutional right to vote. The rally was taken out from the Dr B R Ambedkar statue to BRK Bhavan, drawing participation from leaders, public representatives and activists of various political parties and civil society organisations. Addressing the gathering, Mallu Ravi alleged that the BJP-led government was attempting to weaken the democratic process through the SIR exercise and said the Congress party would strongly oppose any move that undermined the right to vote, which he described as the foundation of Indian democracy. He claimed that

efforts to remove the names of poor people, marginalized sections, tribals, Dalits and other weaker sections from electoral rolls amounted to an attack on the democratic system. Accusing the BJP of misusing the electoral process for political gain, he said such actions threatened both democratic and constitutional rights. Later, Mallu Ravi submitted a memorandum to officials of the Telangana State Election Commission, demanding the immediate withdrawal of the SIR process and seeking safeguards to protect citizens' voting rights. Prominent personalities, including G. Haragopal, Kunamneni Sambasiva Rao and M Kandaram, participated in the protest and expressed support for the protection of democratic rights. Leaders from Congress, CPI, TJS, Left parties, intellectuals and social activists also attended the programme in large numbers.

Theft at Basara temple: Miscreants decamp with silver crown and hundi cash

Nirmal (Telangana), June 23 (UNI)

A theft was reported at the renowned Basara Saraswati Temple in Nirmal district on Tuesday. According to temple authorities, unidentified persons stole a silver crown and a hundi from the Mahakali Temple located on the upper floor of the Saraswati Ammavari Temple complex. The miscreants allegedly broke open the gate of the Mahakali temple and committed the theft. After taking away the cash from the hundi, the culprits reportedly abandoned the emptied hundi near the Vyasa temple and fled the scene. The theft came to light when priests arrived at the temple to perform the

early morning rituals. Temple authorities immediately informed the police. A case has been registered, and an investigation is underway. Police are examining CCTV footage from the temple premises to identify and trace the accused.
