Toddler ‘slapped & pushed’ at Gurgaon daycare

Gurgaon.(Agency)

A two-year-old girl was allegedly slapped, pushed and subjected to physical and mental abuse by a teacher at a preschool daycare centre in Chakkarpur, prompting police to register a case after CCTV footage of the incident came to light. According to police, the girl’s mother, a resident of Sector 28, filed a complaint stating that she had dropped her daughter at the daycare around 9.30am on July 7, as part of the child’s daily routine. When she went back to pick up the toddler around 11.15 am, she noticed that the child’s cheeks were red.The family questioned the daycare teacher, who told them that the child’s cheeks had been red since the morning. “Unsatisfied with the explanation, the parents spoke to the child after returning home. They claimed the toddler indicated through gestures that the teacher had hit her,” a police officer said.The family then requested access to the daycare centre’s CCTV footage. According to the complaint, the footage showed the teacher allegedly slapping and pushing the child and subjecting her to inappropriate treatment inside the facility. Soon after, the family approached Sector 29 police station and filed a complaint against the teacher.Based on that complaint, police registered an FIR against the teacher under Section 75 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, which deals with cruelty towards children. The investigators have seized the CCTV footage and are examining it along with other evidence as part of the probe.Police said they are verifying the sequence of events captured on the CCTV footage and recording the statements of those associated with the daycare centre. They added that appropriate legal action will be taken after examining all the evidence.

Man gets life term for killing father and brother with spade

The sessions court sentenced a Niwari resident, Sunil alias Bablu, to life imprisonment and imposed a fine of Rs 1 lakh for killing his father and brother over land in Dec 2018.

Gurgaon.(Agency)

Believe it or not, the number of single-teacher schools in the state has been rising steeply, putting a question over the learning outcome. This trend is contrary to what is happening in the rest of the country.The latest report of Unified District Information System for Education Plus 2025-26 on school education in India shows that the number of such schools in the state has increased by 20% to 1,278 in 2025-26 from 1,066 a year earlier. It has also highlighted a persistent gap in digital infrastructure across schools.Such schools where a single person teaches multiple classes are common in rural areas. It affects the quality of teaching

and leads to dropouts. A govt school teacher who did not wish to be named said, “When a school has only one teacher, classroom teaching becomes almost impossible to manage. The teacher has to handle multiple grades simultaneously, maintain records, supervise mid-day meals, attend official meetings and complete administrative work, leaving very little uninterrupted teaching time.”The number of single-teacher schools has increased by nearly 47%, from 867 in 2023-24. Teachers said this reflects delays in filling vacant posts and uneven deployment rather than a shortage of qualified candidates. They said sanctioned positions often remain vacant for months, while



existing staff are frequently assigned election duties, surveys, census work and other administrative responsibilities.Student enrolment in these schools has also increased by 6.2%, rising from 43,400 to 46,096. In the previous year, 40,828 students had enrolled in single-teacher schools.The

report also exposes major shortcomings in digital readiness. Of the state’s 23,479 schools, only 9,751 (42%) have functional mobile phones for teachers, leaving more than 13,700 schools without this basic digital resource. Govt schools perform slightly better, with 6,670 of 14,338 schools (46.8%) having functional mobile phones, while only 166 of 546 govt-aided schools (30.4%) have the facility.Among 8,567 private unaided schools, only 4,661 (35.2%) reported having functional mobile phones, while 273 of 574 schools (47.6%) in the ‘Others’ category have access.Smart classroom facilities remain unavailable in a significant number of institutions.

DTCP orders audit of residential society in Gurgaon after concern over balconies

Department of town and country planning (DTCP) has ordered a comprehensive structural audit of Ramprastha Primera in Sector 37D after residents raised concerns over the structural condition of the group housing society, particularly its balconies and projections.In directions issued to Ramprastha Promoters & Developers Pvt. Ltd., district town planner (enforcement) Amit Madholia instructed the developer to undertake a colony-wide structural audit at its own cost. The audit is to be carried out by any one of the four structural engineers empanelled by the committee headed by Gurgaon’s additional deputy commissioner and must begin within the next 15 days.The directions were issued after residents of the society submitted a complaint on Friday, raising concerns over structural

safety.Apart from the audit, the developer has been directed to repair all balconies in the project, irrespective of whether the apartments are occupied or vacant. The order also



mandates rectification of all cracks, plaster defects and any other structural or allied deficiencies identified during the inspection, with the entire expenditure to be borne by the developer.DTCP has asked the developer to ensure the structural

stability and safety of the project during the execution of the repair works. It warned that in the event of any mishap, accident, structural failure or loss of life or property attributable to negligence, non-compliance with the directions or failure to undertake the prescribed remedial measures, the entire responsibility would rest with the developer. The order further states that appropriate legal and regulatory action would be initiated without further notice in case of any violation. A resident of the society said the directive had provided reassurance after repeated concerns over the condition of balconies. “Residents have been worried about safety for quite some time. We hope the audit is conducted independently and all deficiencies are rectified without delay,” the resident said.

Intense shootout in plush Gurgaon colony saw over 60 round fired before 4 gangsters were shot

More than 60 rounds were fired as a lane inside the city’s tony Sushant Lok colony nestled between Beverly Park 1 and Essel Tower became the scene of a fierce gunfight on Thursday night between police and five hired hitmen, who were allegedly sent to a 36-year-old businessman’s house by UK-based gangster Deepak Nandal over an alleged extortion demand of Rs 10 crore. The gunfight ended with four of the shooters,

among them a Class XI student, dead, a fifth critical in hospital, and three cops with bullet injuries. An encounter of this scale is unprecedented in Haryana and also marks extortion crime in Delhi-NCR going several notches up in sheer brazenness.The first shots rang out in Sushant Lok around 9.50 pm, startling the bungalow-lined colony preparing to retire for the night, after the shooters had parked their Scorpio, its registration plate.

NFR Records Consistent Freight Performance with 1025 Rakes Unloaded in June

Maligaon | Northeast Frontier Railway (NFR) maintained its strong freight momentum in June 2026 by registering an impressive unloading performance. During the month, a total of 1,025 freight rakes were unloaded across the zone, reflecting a strong and encouraging freight operations. NFR continued to ensure the uninterrupted transportation of essential and industrial commodities throughout June 2026. Commodities such as food grains, food-grade items, fertilizers, sugar, coal, salt, tank wagons and other goods were handled efficiently at various goods sheds across the zone, enabling timely distribution and reinforcing the reliability of its freight services. A significant share of the freight traffic was dedicated to meeting the requirements of the Northeastern states. Assam accounted for the highest unloading with 589 rakes, comprising 272 rakes of essential commodities and 317 rakes of



non-essential commodities, underscoring the vital role of Railways in supporting public distribution systems, industrial activities and daily consumer needs. During the same period, 68 rakes were unloaded in Tripura, 22 rakes in Nagaland, 20 rakes in Manipur, 8 rakes in Arunachal Pradesh and 5 rakes in Mizoram. In addition, West Bengal recorded the unloading of 184 rakes, while Bihar accounted for 129 rakes comprising both essential and

non-essential commodities, further strengthening regional supply chains, trade connectivity and economic activities across the region. The continuous movement of essential and other commodities is vital for meeting people’s daily needs while supporting and strengthening the region’s economic activities. Effective monitoring at every level has further helped reduce turnaround time and improve overall unloading efficiency.
