

NSCN(IM) breakaway faction forms ‘provisional govt’

DIMAPUR: A breakaway faction of the National Socialist Council of Nagalim (Isak-Muivah), or NSC-N(IM), has announced the formation of a “provisional government”, claiming that the spirit of the 1997 ceasefire agreement with the Centre has “ceased to exist”.

The faction, which calls itself the Eastern Flank, named Ikato I. Chishi Swu, son of late NSCN(IM) co-founder Isak Chishi Swu, as chairman of the provisional government, while

Hs Ramsan was appointed vice-chairman. Several other leaders were also named as members and advisers.

Both Ikato Swu and Ramsan were recently expelled from the NSCN(IM), and their appointments are being seen as a direct challenge to the parent organisation led by veteran Naga leader Thuingaleng Muivah.

The decisions were taken during a meeting of the Eastern Flank at Mt Horeb Camp in Myanmar on Tuesday.

In a statement, the faction said it had decided to consti-



tute a provisional government “until a full-fledged government is formed”, claiming the move was nec-

essary to “save the nation from another surrender” and “rescue the Naga political movement from its

present predicament”. The group also asserted that the spirit of the ceasefire agreement signed between the Centre and the NSCN(IM) in 1997, which paved the way for the Naga peace talks, no longer exists.

The strength of the new faction and the extent of support it has garnered within the insurgent outfit remain unclear.

The development is likely to deepen the internal divisions within the NSC-N(IM) at a time when the long-pending Naga peace process remains unresolved.

Women’s health awareness programme held in Guwahati

GUWAHATI: More than 50 women participated in a health awareness programme organised at Maheshwari Bhawan in Guwahati on Friday to promote preventive healthcare and encourage early detection of common health issues. The programme was joint-

ly organised by BimalaRoop, the social wing of Moped’s House, Assam Maheshwari Seva Trust and Apollo Hospitals, Chennai.

The session was conducted by Prof. Dr. Sumita Samal, senior consultant at Apollo Hospitals, Chennai, who spoke on a range of women’s health issues, including pre-

ventive care, common gynaecological disorders, lifestyle management and the importance of early diagnosis.

The interactive session featured an extensive question-and-answer segment, during which participants sought expert advice on various health concerns. Organisers said the initiative aimed

to create greater awareness about women’s health and encourage timely medical consultation and preventive care.

Representatives of the Assam Maheshwari Seva Trust described the programme as a timely initiative and thanked Dr. Samal and Apollo Hospitals for supporting the event. Participants appreciated the

NTPC announces robust financial performance in Q1 FY27

STANDALONE PAT UP BY 12%, GROUP PAT UP 13%

NEW DELHI: NTPCLtd., India’s largest integrated power utility, has announced its unaudited financial results for the first quarter ended 30.06.2026, reporting a strong all-round performance driven by operational gains and continuing growth.

On a standalone basis, NTPC reported a total income of ₹ 44,512 crore for Q1 FY27, registering a 13% increase as compared to Q1FY 26. Profit After Tax (PAT) for Q1 FY 27 rose to ₹ 5,342 crore up from ₹ 4,775 crore for Q1 FY 26. The PAT growth was primarily driven by gains from capacity additions & operational efficiencies.

On a consolidated basis, NTPC Group’s PAT for Q1 FY27 rose by 13% to ₹ 6,896 crore from ₹ 6,108 for Q1 FY26. The strong performance was bolstered by a 62% increase in the profit from group companies, which reached ₹ 1,832 crore in Q1 FY27 from ₹ 1,131 crore in Q1 FY26.

NTPC’s Coal power stations continue to set industry benchmarks in operational efficiency. NTPC’s coal plants achieved a Plant Load Factor of 76.71% during Q1 FY27, significantly outperforming the Rest of India Coal PLF of 70.32%.

The results reinforce NTPC’s leadership position in India’s power sector, backed by sustained operational excellence and a diversified growth strategy.



ICFRE-RFRI trains M’laya Bamboo Mission officers in scientific bamboo management

JORHAT: The ICFRE–Rain Forest Research Institute (RFRI), Jorhat, successfully conducted a two-day Exposure Visit and Training Programme on Scientific Management of Bamboo for officers of the Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission at its Deoan campus from July 23 to 24.

The programme aimed to strengthen the technical knowledge and practical skills of officers engaged in bamboo development and promotion across Meghalaya. A total of 12 senior officers representing different districts of the state participated in the training. The programme was inaugurated by RFRI Director Dr Nitin Kulkarni, who emphasized the importance of scientific bamboo management

in enhancing productivity, promoting sustainable resource utilization and creating livelihood opportunities across the North East.

The training featured expert lectures on a wide range of subjects, including bamboo propagation, nursery management, commercial cultivation, genetic improvement, pest and disease management, bamboo-based construction, agroforestry systems, bamboo charcoal production, bamboo resource estimation, value addition and marketing.

The technical sessions were conducted by Dr Nitin Kulkarni, R. K. Kalita, Dr Dhruva Jyoti Das, Dr Satyam Bordoloi, Dr Prasan Karmakar, Dr Mitali Mehta, D. K. Meena, Dr R. D. Borthakur, Priyam B. Goswami, Parikshit

Borkotoky, Kumud Borah and Debojit Neog. A major highlight of the programme was the hands-on practical training and field visits to the institute’s bamboo nursery, Bambusetum, Bamboo Charcoal Unit, Bamboo Treatment Unit, Bamboo Museum, Tissue Culture Laboratory and other research facilities. The visits provided participants with first-hand exposure to advanced bamboo technologies and scientific management practices. The programme concluded with a valedictory session during which participants presented the initiatives being undertaken by the Meghalaya State Bamboo Mission.

Certificates were distributed to all 12 participants on successful completion of the training.

East Siang ADC asks departments to improve project delivery

PASIGHAT : East Siang’s in-charge deputy commissioner, Pebika Lego, on Friday directed government departments to ensure timely and quality execution of development projects while strengthening coordination to improve public service delivery across the district.

Chairing the District Development Review-cum-District Level Monitoring Committee (DDR-cum-DLMC) meeting at the DC’s conference hall, Lego reviewed the progress of various government programmes in the presence of Zilla Parishad chairperson Ruth Tabing Boko, Zilla Parishad members and heads of departments. The ADC asked departments to complete projects within stipulated timelines and present field-level challenges so that timely interventions could be made. She also directed the education department to submit its Action Taken

Report at the earliest and reviewed the functioning of the agriculture, veterinary and fisheries departments, seeking details of banking-related delays and other bottlenecks affecting implementation of government schemes.

Calling for greater administrative efficiency, Lego advised departments to hold regular internal review meetings before submitting reports to ensure accuracy and better coordination. She also urged officials to involve the district information and public relations office in awareness campaigns and training programmes for wider public outreach.

Highlighting East Siang’s tourism potential, the ADC said several villages could be developed as tourist destinations through coordinated efforts involving the Pasighat Municipal Council, Panchayati Raj Institutions and local communities.

She further appealed to all departments to enrol eligible



casual workers, ALCs and staff under social security schemes such as the Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana and Atal Pension Yojana, while ensuring timely renewals. During the meeting, deputy director of school education Adhuk Tabing flagged difficulties in securing Land Possession Certificates for schools, stating that many institutions are located on forest land or on plots donated by families who are now reluctant to issue no-objection certificates, with some seeking government jobs for family members in return. Zilla Parishad chairperson

Ruth Tabing Boko stressed the need for close coordination between departments and elected representatives, saying grassroots-level co-operation was essential for resolving local issues and ensuring effective implementation of development programmes.

Luxmi Tea wins national award for workplace safety, POSH compliance

GUWAHATI: Kolkata-based Luxmi Tea Co Pvt Ltd has been honoured with the Excellence in POSH Governance & Compliance Award at the 4th National POSH Conclave & Excellence Awards 2026 in New Delhi for its efforts to create safer and more inclusive workplaces for women across its tea estates.

The award, presented at a conclave organised by NoMeansNo, an initiative of the Centre for Skill Development & Training (CSDT) with support from the Delhi government’s department of women and child development, recognises the company’s implementation of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace

(Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. The company said it has conducted 144 POSH awareness workshops over the past two years, covering around 10,000 permanent and temporary workers in local languages across tea estates, factories and corporate offices. Estate-level POSH Champions, strengthened Internal Committees and regular visits by senior legal officials have been introduced to improve grievance redressal and build workers’ confidence.

Beyond workplace safety, the company has launched initiatives to promote women’s economic empowerment through self-help groups, beekeeping, weaving and tea tourism. Mothers’ Clubs and Adolescent Girls’ Clubs have also been formed to promote

health, education and gender awareness, while scholarships and vocational training are helping the children of tea garden workers, particularly girls, pursue higher education and careers. Company officials said the award reflects its commitment to ensuring dignity, safety and equal opportunities for women in the tea industry.
